(3) That the said Caroline B. Moseley, her heirs and assigns, shall have the right without charge or costs of any kind to make as many three-quarter inch taps on the said two inch water pipe line as may be necessary to furnish water to each and every lot or any subdivision of said lots shown in Block "A" and "B" on plat of Hillandale Heights, recorded in Plat Book "Y", Page 113, R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C.

(4) That other than the three-quarter inch taps on the water pipe line permitted to be made by the said Caroline B. Moseley so as to furnish water to any lot or to any subdivision of said lots on plat of Hillandale Heights, it is agreed that neither of the parties hereto shall permit any other taps to be made on the two inch water pipe line without the consent of the other party hereto. In the event the parties hereto should agree for additional taps to be made on said two inch water pipe line, the charge therefor shall first be mutually agreed upon and any amount received for such tap or taps on the water pipe line shall be equally divided between the said Caroline B. Moseley and Robert D. Nelligan.

To the faithful performance of these covenants the parties hereto bind themselves and their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns.
