all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Bates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina lying on East side of a County Road and bounded by Lots deeded to A. I. Edwards and Ruth G. Edwards and Lot to Marshall W. Edwards and other land of Grantor, containing 0.41 Acre, more or less, and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at a point in County Road from J. K. Keeler's corner N. 41-40 W. 100 feet and running thence N. 41-40 W. 100 feet to point in road; thence N. 69-55 E. 208.4 feet to iron pin; thence S. 41-40 E. 85 feet to iron pin; thence S. 66-07 W. 203.9 feet to beginning.
