all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township Greenville County,

State of South Carolina,

on Enoree River about one-half mile north of the town of Taylors, adjoining lands of J. E. Flynn, the Estate of Alfred Taylor and others, having the following metes and bounds, viz;

Beginning at the mouth of Mountain Creek where it empties into the said Enoree River, running thence up the said creek as the line to an iron pin on the said J. E.
