in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 ... in the State aforesaid, and other valuable considerations, ... DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said THOMAS D. CHRISTOPHER, his heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land on the Northwest side of Sir Abbot Street, in the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as the greater portion of Lot No. 93 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through November, 1952, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Plat Book "GG", pages 2 and 3, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northwest side of Sir Abbot Street at joint front corner of Lots 93 and 94 and running thence with the line of Lot 94, N. 27-14 E., 183.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 60-01 W., 72.09 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 93; thence through Lot 93, being at all points 3 feet northeast of and parallel with joint line of Lots 92 and 93, S. 27-14 E., 180.1 feet more or less to an iron pin on the Northwest side of Sir Abbot Street, said pin being 3 feet Northeast of the joint front corner of Lots 92 and 93; thence along the Northwest side of Sir Abbot Street, N. 62-46 E., 72 feet to the beginning corner.
