

V. The continuing partners jointly and severally covenant with the retiring partner that they or one of them will duly pay and satisfy all debts and liabilities of the said partnership hereby dissolved, except only such debts, if any, as may have been contracted by the retiring partner and have not been entered in the partnership accounts; and, further, that they will at all times effectually indemnify and keep indemnified the retiring partner, his heirs, executors, and administrators from the said debts and liabilities, and from all actions, proceedings, costs, claims, and demands in respect thereof.

VI. The retiring partner hereby covenants with the continuing partners that they may continue to use the Trade Name for a period up to 3 months from date with the proviso however, that in the event other parties other than the continuing partners purchase an interest, such a change will terminate this particular covenant effective 30 days or ~~months~~<sup>dis</sup> from date of that event.
