

PAGE SIXAGREEMENT

Touchberry. The accounts shall be settled and the proceeds divided according to the manner stipulated herein in Paragraph (4). It is understood that this agreement shall terminate at the demand of any party hereto if any of the parties shall be adjudged bankrupt or if a receiver shall be appointed for him, or if any other type of insolvency proceedings are instituted against any of the parties hereto, it being understood that the Royal Cleaners, whether or not incorporated, shall be a party to this agreement for such purposes and that the provisions herein shall apply to said Royal Cleaners.

13. Touchberry shall have the right to make adjustments of all complaints of customers, it being understood, however, that he will consult with Delaney and Sullivan in such matters, but that, because said tuxedo and other formal wear rentals shall be conducted so as to appear to be a part of Touchberry's business, he shall handle such complaints in the usual manner as that of his own business.

14. The business shall be conducted in a standard of dignity in harmony with the business of Touchberry in such a manner that will not be detrimental to any other business of the parties hereto.

15. In the event that the parties deem it advisable or necessary to rent from other sources tuxedos and other formal wear and accessories thereto, the cost of such rental shall be paid from the gross proceeds from said business before division thereof.
