All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with the improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the eastern side of Webster Street in the Slater Manufacturing Company Village in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, and known and designated as Lot 27, Block D, as shown on a plat entitled "Plat of Village, S.
