The family burial ground, not exceeding one-half an acre right-of-way to same is reserved to the grantor and her heirs.

ALSO, All that certain tract of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, BEGINNING At a stone in Southeast corner of the Mary B. Pressley tract and running thence with line of Saluda Land and Lumber Company, N. 82-40 E. 35.42 chs. to a stone; corner of J. Walter Gray Tract; thence N. 4-00 E. 42.40 chs. to a stone; thence N. 12-00 E. 24.68 chs. to a poplar on Road to Caesar's Head; thence N. 36 W. 4.24 chs. to a stone; thence N. 54-20 W. 12.94 chs. to a stone; thence S. 19-00 W. 84.33 chs. to the beginning corner, containing 184 acres, more or less. Being known as Parcel II of the George Bishop Tract.

ALSO, All that tract known as the State Grant Tract (near Jones Gap Road), located near the Old Jones Gap and in upper Greenville County, South Carolina, containing some 10.4 acres and bounded on the North by the Bishop No. 1 tract; on the South by the Jones Tract; and on the West by the Bradford Tract, obtained by grant from the State of South Carolina in conformity with a Resolution of the Commissioner of the Sinking Fund directing the sale, and adopted on the 9th day of March, 1906; recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County on December 27, 1907 in Book "B", at page 159. The land is located on the head waters of the middle fork of the Saluda River and has such shapes and forms and marks as are represented by a Plat of same on file in the Office of the Secretary of State in Book 2 of Public Land Plats at page 90.

BEGINNING At a stone near Matthews Creek, corner of Saluda Land & Lumber Company and running thence N. 71-15 E. 25.11 chs. to a stone; thence S. 19-51 E. 45.96 chs. to a stone; thence S. 70-10 W. 18.45 chs. to a Spruce Pine on Matthews Creek; thence with Matthews Creek southernly to a stone; thence S. 67-30 W. 20-53 chs. to a stone; thence N. 20-20 W. 33.30 chs.
