That I, Mary Parker in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of ten dollars love and affection DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Leland Parker, his heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel, or lot of land lying and being in Glassy Mt. Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina having the following description, known as a part of the Robert Parker land:

Beginning at the old Sourwood corner and running thence S 36.45 W 198 feet to an iron pin; thence N 60.00 W 755 feet to a stake; thence N 40.15 E, 50 feet to a stake; thence N 52.00 W 418 feet to a stake; thence N 65.00 W 10 feet to a stake near the branch above the waterfalls; thence N 65.00 W 50 feet to a stake; thence S 18.30 W 100 feet to a stake; thence N 86.30 W 300 feet to an iron pin on the west side of a road; thence N 64.30 W 304 feet to a stone on the west bank of a small branch, the Will Parker corner; thence with his line N 15.30 W 522 feet to a stone, Green's corner; thence N 15.30 W 29 feet to a stake on the old line; thence with same line S 58.45 W 2178 feet to the beginning corner, containing nine acres more or less.

This is a portion of the same land deeded to me by Robert Parker and is recorded in the A.M.C Office for Greenville County in vol. 108, page 114.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
