to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry W. Goldsberry, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the south side of the White Horse Road and being shown as Lot No. 24 on Plat of Property of Pecan Terrace recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", page 9 and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of the White Horse Road at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24 and running thence with the joint line of said lots S. 58-06 W. 187.8 feet to an iron pin on rear line of Lot No. 35; thence with the rear line of Lots Nos. 35 and 34 N. 31-22 W. 65 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 25; thence with the line of that lot N. 56-30 E. 183.5 feet to an iron pin on the south side of the White Horse Road; thence with said Road S. 33-11 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is conveyed subject to the building restrictions as set forth on the above plat and as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 477, page 291. (Any fuel or oil tank shall be enclosed in the building structure or placed underground.)
