KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That SOUTHERN BLEACHERY & PRINT WORKS, INC., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Delaware, Grantor, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, in hand paid by DUKE POWER COMPANY, a New Jersey corporation, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and of the agreements on the part of Duke Power Company to be performed as hereinafter set out, does hereby grant unto said Duke Power Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and easement to go in and upon the land of Grantor at its plant at Taylors in Greenville County, South Carolina, which land is shown on print File No. 152-82 dated June 29, 1954, hereto attached and made a part hereof; and to construct, maintain and operate in, upon and through said premises in a proper manner with towers, poles, wires, guys and other necessary apparatus and appliances, a line for transmitting power by electricity and for telephone purposes, together with the right at all times to enter said premises for the purpose of inspecting said line and making necessary repairs and alterations thereon, together with the right at all times to cut away and keep clear of said line for a distance of 34 feet on each side of the center line of same all trees and other obstructions that may, in any way, endanger or interfere with the proper maintenance and operation of said line, with the right to cut or top any trees outside of said 34 foot distance which, if they should fall or be cut or blown down, might strike said line.

The center line of said right of way has been marked out on the ground and is shown by red line on the attached print and thereon indicated "Relocation", and extends from pole #12 of the Power Company's present 44 KV line to station 5/73.5 and thence to pole #9 as shown on said print.
