CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

1841

WHEREAS, FRED L. CROW, LEWIS M. DAVIS, MARION E. LANFORD,
AND ROBERT F. WILLIAMS.

all of Greer, S. C.

did on the 7th. day of September, 19 54, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is GREER GOLF AND COUNTRY CLUB

THIRD: That the principal place of business is
GREER, S. C.
(COUNTY OF GREENVILLE)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to organize, promote and maintain a social and athletic club; to operate and maintain a golf course and also all kinds of other athletic sports and games that may be deemed advisable by the directors of said corporation and to that end it shall have all the rights, powers, privileges and immunities usual, necessary and customary in order to successfully prosecute its objects and purposes. The corporation shall have the full power and authority to purchase, lease and otherwise acquire, hold, mortgage, convey and otherwise dispose of all kinds of property, both real and personal, both in this State and in all other States, Territories and Dependencies of the United States, and generally to perform all acts which may be deemed necessary or expedient for the proper and successful prosecution of the objects and purposes for which the corporation is created.

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is 200 shares at no par value
payable in cash. ~~Shares~~

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Two Hundred (200)
of the par value of no par value ~~Dollars~~

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 21st. day of
July, 19 54, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-
ing were elected directors: Fred L. Crow, Lewis M. Davis, John Ratterree, Robert F. Williams, Dan D. Davenport, Marion E. Lanford, James M. Hughes, Miller West, and Virgil Q. Cox

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Fred L. Crow ;
as Vice-President, Lewis M. Davis ; as Secretary, Robert F. Williams ;
as Treasurer, Marion E. Lanford

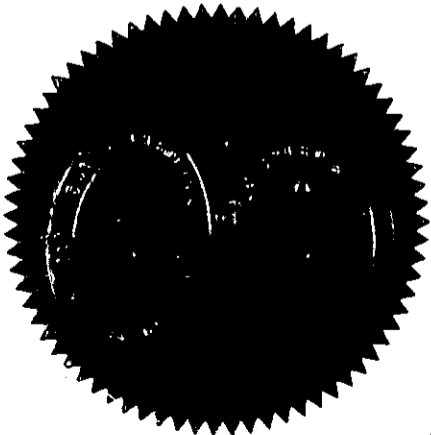
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amend-
ments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed
by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greer Citizen

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the
aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
