W. E. McClain, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in Gantt Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on the north side of Rocky Knoll Drive being Lot No. 52 in a subdivision known as Pecan Terrace, plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "GG", page 9 and being more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the north side of Rocky Knoll Drive at joint front corner of Lots Nos. 53 and 52 and running thence with said joint line N. 53-41 E. 174.1 feet to an iron pin on the rear line of Lot No. 43; thence with the rear line of Lots No. 43 and 44 N. 28-24 W. 111.85 feet to an iron pin rear corner of Lot No. 50; thence with the rear line of that lot S. 38-50 W. 72.3 feet to corner of Lot No. 51; thence with the line of that lot S. 53-16 W. 131 feet to an iron pin on Rocky Knoll Drive; thence with Rocky Knoll Drive S. 34 E. 69.3 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is part of the same conveyed to me by A. C. Mann by his deed dated January 2, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 497, page 488.

These lots are conveyed subject to the building restrictions as set forth on the above plat and as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 477, page 291. Any fuel or oil tank shall be enclosed in the building structure or placed underground.
