(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these pres-
ents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said <u>Margaret Jann Crower</u> , has been and assigns forever:

All that lot of land with the buildings and improvements the recomposition of East Earle Street, in the Sity of Greenville in Greenville County, S. C., being shown as a continuous lot 19 of section G on plat of property of Stone Land County, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C., in Plat Book A, at Page 337 through 345, inclusive, and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. L. Colt n. March 27, 1951, the following metes and bounds to-wit:

BECINNING at an iron pin on the South side of East Parle Street at joint front corner of lots 17 and 19 of section 3, sail nin also being 480 feet East from the Southeast corner of the intersection of East Earle Street and Bennett Street, and sanning thence with the line of lot 17 S. 18-13 W. 150 feet to make in pin; thence S. 71-20 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence M. 18-13 E. 150 feet to an iron pin on the South side of last sarle Street; thence along the South side of East Earle Street M. 71-2 W. 60 feet to the beginning corner.

As a part of the consideration for this deed the mantes accounts and agrees to pay that mortgage given by whom w. Children, Jr. to C. Douglas Wilson and Co. in the origin 1 amount of file, 700.00, dated Lay 4, 1951, recorded in the M. M. C. Office for Greenville County S.
