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In consideration of One (\$1.00) Dollar in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, DUKE POWER COMPANY, a corporation, hereby grants, upon the terms and conditions herein set out, to SCITHERN BELL.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY, a corporation, its licensees, successors and assigns, the right to construct, operate and maintain a line of poles, wires, anchors and buried cable for the operation of its telephone business in, upon and across certain lands of Duke Power Company hereinafter referred to in Greenville and Pickens Counties, South Carolina, with the right to cut down or trim and keep trimmed all trees and undergrowth within ten (10) feet of said line.

The lands upon which the right of way hereby granted is located are (1) the tract of land known as the R. A. Means tract I described in deed Greenville from Carolina Power Company to Southern Public Utilities Company dated recember 29, 1916, recorded in the Public Registry of Greenville Courty in Vol. 33, page 97, and in the Public Registry of Pickens County in Vol. WM, page 162; and said right of way shall be located upon said lands substantially as shown by red line on print hereto attached and made a part hereof.

It is understood that the Telephone Company will place two (2) poles, an anchor and guys and approximately 250 feet of Parier cable on well-right of way.

In case the right of way hereby grue, on or in line to the constructed thereon shall at any time interfere with Dake Telephore Company's uncount said lands or any portion of same, the Telephone Company will of its own contant expense remove said line from the lands of Dake Power To purp and there—upon this right of way shall be of no further force or effect.

The rights hereby granted and the conditions attached thereby
