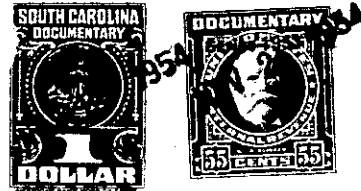

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. S. Smith,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 82 of Section 4, of a subdivision of the Judson Mills Village, as shown on plat thereof made by Dalton and Neves, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K, at page 75, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the south side of Sixth Street at the corner of Lot No. 81, which point is approximately 209 feet east of the Southeast corner of the intersection of Sixth Street and Neubert Street, and running thence along the South side of Sixth Street, N. 88-20 E. 70 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-42 E. 121.8 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 88-10 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lot No. 81; thence along the line of said Lot No. 81, N. 1-42 W. 122.1 feet to the beginning corner, being the same property conveyed to C.
