All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chicks Springs

Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 164 Halsey Street of Subdivision known as Piedmont Estates and being shown on plat thereof made by Dalton & Neves, December 1944 and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the joint front corner of Lots 164 and 165 and running thence with the joint line of said lots, South 24-0 West 175 feet to an iron pin; running thence North 66-0 West 58 feet to an iron pin; running thence N $^{\circ}$ 24-0 East 175 feet to an iron pin on Halsey Street; running thence with Halsey Street, South 66-0 East 58 feet to the point of beginning.
