That I, George T. JOSEPH, her heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the Southern side of Monticello Avenue, in the City of Greenville, being shown as Lot No. 119 on Plat of Glenn Grove Park made by W. E. Dalton in May, 1924, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "D" at Page 233, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Southern side of Monticello Avenue, 71 feet east from Grace Street at corner of Lot No. 120, and running thence with the line of said lot, S. 27-18 W. 185.7 feet to a stake; thence N. 72-20 W. 50.7 feet to a stake at corner of Lot No. 118; thence with the line of said lot, N. 27-18 E. 114.2 feet to a stake on Monticello Avenue; thence with the Southern side of Monticello Avenue, S. 02-42 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This lot is one of the lots conveyed to me by Bertha K. Parrell by deed dated January 7, 1942, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Deed Volume 372, at Page 256.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
