

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Harold E. Brooks, his heirs and assigns forever;

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being described as tract #1, and # of a plat made by H. C. Bailey, January 1920, and containing 00 acres, more or less, as per said plat and having the following rates and bounds to wit;

BEGINning at a stone at Jordan's corner, and running thence N 36-17 E 26.7 feet to a stake, thence S 73 E 0180 to a nail in pine, thence N 73 E 125 feet to iron pin, corner of lot #1; thence with lot #1, S-50.4 W 742 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along line of lot #1 S 58-50 W 463 feet to an iron pin; thence eastward lots #1 and #2; thence along the line of lot 1 S. 16-46 W. 1646 feet to an iron pin; to joint corner of lots #1 and #2; thence in the same direction 1646 feet to the beginning corner, and containing tract of land conveyed to Harry L.
