C. in Plat Book V, at page 135, (also shown on plat recorded in Plat Book CC at page 23), and having, according to a survey made by R. K Campbell and J. L. Alvin Gilreath, N. 83-14½ W. 1222.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 25-19 E. 345 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-36 E. 53.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 79-26 E. 28 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 10-36 E. 60 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 79-26 W. 40 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10-36 W. 113.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 25-19 W. 344.7 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 4-15 W. 293 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 8-00 E. 1048 feet to an iron pin in the center of State Road 23106; thence along the center of said road, N. 78-0 E. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing with said StateRoad due east, 251 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 25.3 acres, more or less.
