All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Bates Township, on the west side of the Geer Highway, and being known and designated as part of Lot No. 1 of the property of O. A. Foster, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book T, at Page 115, and having, according to a more recent survey made by H. T. Corn, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
