ALL that lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of Scarlett Street (formerly known as Forest Green Road), near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot 223 on plat of Sherwood Forest, made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, August, 1951, revised through June, 1953, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "GG", pages 2 and 3 (also recorded in Plat Book "GG", pages 70 and 71) and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and his Heirs and Assigns forever.

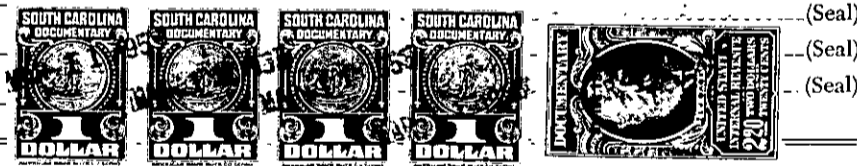
