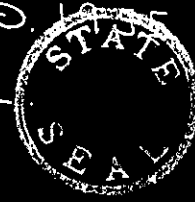

CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, EDWIN BIHARI, 214 Aberdeen Drive, Greenville, S. C.
and

did on the 16th. day of March, 1955, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is LUTHI & KNIGHT HOME CONSTRUCTION
CO., INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.
(214 Aberdeen Drive)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is construct buildings of all
types, repair and remodel buildings of all types, buy and sell building supplies
and materials and related supplies and materials, to buy, sell and mortgage
real estate and to do all other acts which a corporation may do under the
laws of South Carolina

FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Thirty Thousand (\$30,000.00) - - - - - Dollars
payable on demand

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Three Hundred (300)
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00) - - - - - Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 15th. day of
March, 1955, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-
ing were elected directors:

Edwin Bihari, Perry S. Luthi and Don W. Knight

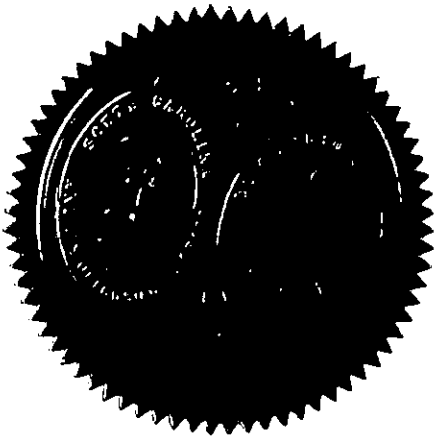
EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, Perry S. Luthi ;
as Vice-President, Don W. Knight ; as Secretary, Edwin Bihari ;
as Treasurer, Perry S. Luthi

NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amend-
ments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed
by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Greenville Piedmont
a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the
aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
