CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, C. C. PEARCE, JR. AND JAMES T. PEARCE

both of Greenville, S. C.

did on the 29th. day of March, 1955, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration, signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is P-Y-A DISTRIBUTING CO. OF GREENVILLE, INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is

(a) to engage in brokerage, wholesale and retail distribution of beers, ales and allied malt products, and to buy, sell and otherwise deal in said beers, ales and allied malt products as broker, wholesaler and at retail. (b) To act as agent or representative of individuals, firms or corporations manufacturing or selling beers, ales and allied malt products. (c) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, improve, lease, sublease, assign, transfer, mortgage or encumber or in any manner acquire or dispose of real estate, warehouses, storehouses, dwellings, garages or other buildings or real property. (d) To purchase, own, lease or otherwise acquire trucks and automobiles and other motor driven vehicles and to operate same for the purpose of distributing the products handled by the corporation and in carrying on the corporation business with the full right to sell, exchange, transfer, mortgage or encumber said motor vehicles as the corporation may elect. (e) To purchase or otherwise acquire from time to time shares of its own capital stock or capital stock of any other corporation with the right to own, hold, sell, assign, transfer or otherwise exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership thereof. (f) To carry on any and all lawful business, enter into contracts, maintain and operate machinery and appliances, incur or assume debts and obligations, purchase franchises, businesses and assume debts, contracts and obligations thereof, maintain warehousing buildings and plants and to generally perform all acts which may be deemed necessary and expedient to the proper conduct of the objects and purposes for which the corporation is created.
