"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the east side of High Valley Boulevard, near the City of Greenville, in Gantt Township, being shown as Lot No. 31 on the plat of Fresh Meadow Farms, made by M. H. Woodward, May 21, 1945, recorded in Plat Book M at page 127, and described as follows:
