WHEREAS, George W. Stone has previously conveyed unto Gourney E. Moore a tract of land containing 30.40 acres, more or less in Fairview Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, by a deed which is recorded in the office of the R. M. C., Greenville County in Deed Book 327, Page 333.

AND WHEREAS, the mentioned tract of land lies in the rear of other lands owned by the said George W. Stone with the only means of ingress and egress thereto being through and over the lands of the said George W. Stone;

NOW in order to permit the said Gourney E. Moore, his successors and assigns to have ingress and egress to the mentioned parcel of land, I the said George W. Stone, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar to me in hand paid do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gourney E. Moore, his heirs and assigns, the right and privilege of entering upon the said 30.40 acres of land over and through other lands of myself with the entry into and from the said lands being over and along a road which now exists leading from the Neely-Ferry Road back to the mentioned parcel of land or over, along and across any other road which may in the future be substituted for the existing road, with such change of location if any should be had being left entirely in the discretion of the said George W. Stone, his heirs and assigns, of the property over which any such new road might be located;
