be heard on the 13th day of January 1955,  
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged  
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,  
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to James Richard McCullough  
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear;

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County  
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release  
Lydia Mae McCullough and  
unto the said James Richard McCullough, all the right, title and interest  
of Albert Melton Harris, a minor, the same being an undivided one-half in-  
terest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township,  
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing one-half (1/2)  
acres, more or less, lying on Highway No. 29 between Piedmont and Pelzer,  
and having the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at corner of J. E. Boiters line, thence in an easterly direc-  
tion along line of J. E. Boiter 271 feet to corner of J. E. Boiter lot and  
Piedmont & Northern Ry. line; thence North along line of Piedmont & Northern  
Ry. Co. 75 feet to iron pin, corner of D. M. Tinsley line, thence in a  
western direction along line of D. M. Tinsley 236 feet to an iron pin in  
the center of Highway No. 29; thence South along Highway No. 29, 100 feet  
to the beginning corner.

This being the same piece, parcel or lot of land conveyed to Irene D.  
Harris and Albert Melton Harris by deed by Benjamin F. Duke the 21st day of
