Office for Greenville County in Plat Book II, at Page /39, it is therefore mutually agreed between the parties hereto as follows:

(1) That the said Charles H. Lawton, as Trustee, his successors and assigns, shall have a right-of-way across the property of Mrs. Clara Bates Turner designated as Lot No.3 on a Plat recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "V", at Page 195. Said right-of-way shall extend from the South Saluda River across Lot No.3 and to the property being purchased this date by Charles H.
