All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, in the Pleasant Grove Church community, lying on the south side of the Brushy Creek Road, being bounded on the north by the said road and other lands of myself, on the east and south by other lands of myself and on the west by lot being conveyed this day by me to E. P. and Ola Mae P. Barton, and being a part of tract No. 1 as shown on Plat of Property of John G. Greer Estate, recorded in the E. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book FF at pages 204 and 205, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-

Beginning on a nail and stopper in the center of the said road, joint corner of the lot being conveyed to E. P. and Ola Mae P. Barton, and runs thence with the line of this lot S. 38-55 E. 21 feet to a stake on the south bank of the road, then continueing for a total distance of 220 feet to a stake on the said line; thence N. 49-55 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence N. 38-55 E. 220 feet to a nail and stopper in the center of the said road (stake back on line at 21 feet); thence with the center of the said road S. 49-55 W. 200 feet to the beginning corner, containing One (1) acre, more or less.
