CHARTER  
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS,

C. E. SLATTON, W. M. DILLARD JR., AND JAMES B. SUDDUTH

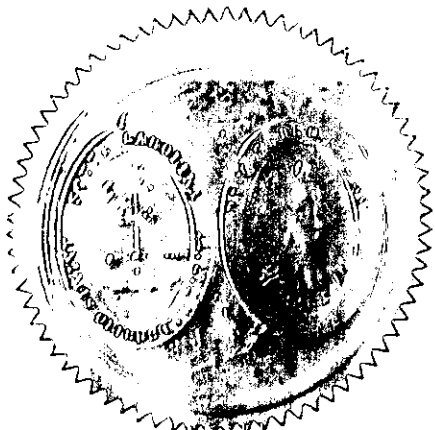
did on the 26th day of May, 19 55, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,  
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is S D &amp; S MOTOR COMPANY

THIRD: That the principal place of business is at Dillard and Slatton Service Station,  
Route 5, Greer, S. C. (Greenville County)FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is the selling of  
automobiles, trucks and other vehicles, at both retail and wholesale,  
and the repairing of same.FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Twelve Thousand (\$12,000.00) - - - - - Dollars  
payable in cash or its equivalentSIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Twenty Four (24)  
shares of the par value of Five Hundred (\$500.00) per share Dollars.SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 16th day of  
May, 19 55, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-  
ing were elected directors: C. E. Slatton, W. M. Dillard, Jr., and James B. SudduthEIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, James B. Sudduth ;  
as Vice-President, W. M. Dillard, Jr. ; as Secretary, C. E. Slatton ;  
as Treasurer, C. E. SlattonNINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amend-  
ments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed  
by *bona fide* subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice  
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in

The Greer Citizen a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the  
afore-said Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws  
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to  
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the  
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.GIVEN under my hand and the seal of the State, at Columbia,  
this 26th day of May  
in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and  
Fifty-five and in the one hundred and  
79th year of the Independence of the
