(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by
these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wade L. Mosteller and
Maefeen M. Mosteller and their Heirs and Assigns forever

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in ONeal Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina lying on the north side of a County Road
that lead from Little Texas School to Jackson Grove Church and bounded
on west by tract conveyed to Thomas and Corine B. Mosteller and on
north and east by South Beaverdam Creek and Containing Two and 75/100
Acres, more or less, and having the following Metes and Bounds:

Beginning at an iron pipe, corner of tract conveyed to Thomas
and Corine B. Mosteller and on the north side of County Road and
running thence N. 9-38 W. 100 feet to iron pipe; thence N. 23-03 E.
513 feet to iron pin on bank of creek; thence along meanders of
creek down stream southeasterly 666 feet to iron pipe on west bank
