TIMMONS, JR. and M. T. PATRICK, their heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 59 according to Plat of Section I of Lake Forest, which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book "GG", page 17, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeastorly side of Tranquil Avenue, joint front corner Lots 59 and 60, and running thence S. 8-24 E. 215.2 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 59 and 60; thence N. 59-09 E. 77.9 feet to a point; thence N. 61-0 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner Lots 58 and 59; thence N. 30-43 W. 172.6 feet to an iron pin on the South-casterly side of Tranquil Avenue, joint front corner Lots 58 and 59; thence around the curve of Tranquil Avenue, the chord of which is S. 61-34 W. 30 feet and S. 62-21 W. 30 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning.
