Know All Men by These Presents:

That we, Life L. Richbourg and Lila M. Richbourg, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five and 10/100 DOLLARS,

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bythel Oatis Warrell and Pauline Lee Warrell

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and in Butler Township, being known and identified as Lot Number forty-nine (49) as shown on plat of property of Morningside, drawn by Dalton & Jones, Engineers in December, 1952, which plat is of record in the S. C. Office for said County and State in Plat Book "F" at page 85, reference to which plat is hereby made; said lot of land being described by metes and bounds as follows, to wit:

BEGLINING at an iron pin on the Southern side of Estanolle Street as shown on said plat at the corner common to Lots Number 48 and 49, and running thence South 15-03 East, along the dividing line between Lots 48 and 49, two Hundred Forty-seven and 1/10 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the center line of a certain Creek shown on said plat; thence following the center line of said Creek in a Northwesterly direction, a traverse line of which runs North 03-24 West Ninety and 3/10 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing along the center line of said Creek in a Southwesterly direction, a traverse line of which runs South 7-53 West Eighty-five and 1/10 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot Number 50; thence along the dividing line between Lots 49 and 50 North 15-53 West two Hundred feet, more or less, to the Southern side of Estanolle Street; thence along the Southern side of Estanolle Street North 75-03 East two Hundred Twenty-nine and 9/10 feet to the place of beginning.

This property is subject to the restrictions and covenants contained in a certain deed of trust dated January 20, 1953, and recorded in Deed Book 470, page 539, and to the additional restriction that: "all tanks, barrels and certain other fuel oil shall be kept on the surface of the ground or concealed."

The above described lot of land was conveyed by the grantors herein to the above named grantees on January 17, 1955, by deed recorded in Deed Book 517, page 124, in which deed there was an error in the book and page there set out and the deed is hereby corrected, and this deed is given to correct such error.

TOGETHER with all and singular the Rights, Members, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the said Premises before mentioned unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and their Heirs and Assigns forever.

And the grantor(s) do(es) hereby bind the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the grantee(s) hereinabove named, and the grantee's(s) Heirs and Assigns against the grantor(s) and the grantor's(s) Heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
