these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said R. L. Garrison

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Gantt Township, in Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as a portion of  
Tract No. 2, in the sub-division of the lands of C. A. Settersfield, as shown  
on plat thereof, made by John C. Smith on August 2<sup>nd</sup> + 16<sup>th</sup>, 1948, as  
recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book T, at Page  
29, and having the following mates and bounds, to wit:-

Beginning at a point in the center of a public road at the corner  
of property now or formerly belonging to Cox, and running thence along the  
center of said public road, N. 4° 00' W. 100 feet to an iron pin in the center  
of said road; thence on a newline across other property of the grantor,  
N. 85-05 E. 300 feet to an iron pin; thence continuing by another newline  
across property of grantor, S. 400 E. 100 feet to an iron pin in the south  
line of grantor's property, which is also in the line of the Cox property;  
thence along the line of the Cox property S. 85-05 W. 300 feet to  
the beginning corner.
