All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Chick Springs Township, near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, lying on the west side of Wood's Drive, and on the north side of a proposed new road, and being a part of tract No. 3 as shown on Plat of Property of John G. Greer, L. B. Vaughn, I. M. Wood and J. A. Wood, said plat made by W. A. Christopher, Surveyor, November 1921, and having the following courses and distances, to wit:-
