FIRST TRACT: Lying entirely in Henderson County, Rorth Carolina, and being the first tract allotted to Margaret Hughes in the Report of the Commissioners filed September 21, 1935, in a Special Proceeding then pending in Hendersor County, North Carolina entitled Largaret Hughes versus Mary A. M. Rea, etal, said Proceeding appearing of record in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court for Henderson County, N. C. in Special Proceeding Minute Docket 9 at Page at pages 395, et seq. and said Report of Commissioners and the Judgment confirming the same also appearing of record in the office of the Register of Deeds for Henderson County, N.
