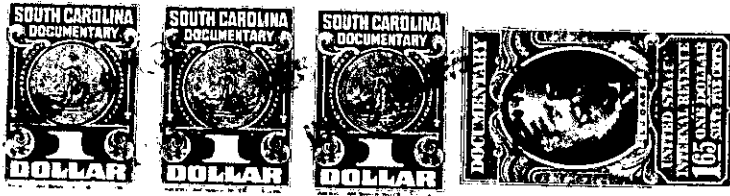

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Greenville County Deed Book 118, page 312

a corporation chartered under the laws of the State of South Carolina

of the sum of Fifteen Hundred - Dollars,

to it in hand duly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the grantee
hereinafter named (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), has granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto Robert Arnold
his Heirs and Assigns forever:

" All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in
Grove Township, County and State aforesaid and being more fully
described as follows: Beginning on a Stone, Charles corner, and
running thence S. 3/4 E. 9.96 chains to an iron pin in road leading
from Bessie to Piedmont; thence along said road S. 85 W. 0.30 to
pin; thence N. 71-50 W. 6.27 to iron pin; thence N. 10-20 E. 5.00
to stone; thence N. 81 E. 4.71 to stone; thence S. 39 1/2 E. 1.25 to
the beginning corner, and containing four acres, more or less."
