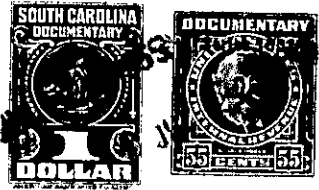

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Allie M. McClure, Evelyn M. Landis and Richard M. McClure of Polk County, North Carolina

~~have granted~~ in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Seventy-Five and No/100 (\$375.00) Dollars

to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by M. B. Gazaway and L. B. Bristol of Spartanburg County, South Carolina

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said M. B. Gazaway and L. B. Bristol, their heirs and assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and described as follows:

All that certain tract of land lying and being in Glassy Mountain Township, Greenville County, S. C., known as lot #9 of the Estate of J. M. McClure subdivision named in his last will, having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances:

Beginning on stone on the Lockhart and Pruitt corner; thence N. 39 W. 12.00 to a stone; thence N. 59 E. 2.92 to a stake; thence N. 39 W. 2.32 to point in road; thence S. 58 E. 11.70 to a stake on the branch; thence N. 28 1/2 E. 7.50 to beginning corner. Containing 6-1/4 acres, more or less.

The above described property was conveyed to Garrison McClure by the following two deeds: (1) An undivided one-half interest in said land was conveyed to Garrison McClure by Alender McClure, Administrator, by deed dated December 14, 1929, recorded in Book 127, at Page 556, Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, South Carolina, and (2) an undivided one-half interest in said land was conveyed to Garrison McClure by Alender McClure by deed dated November 14, 1931, recorded in Vol. 479, Page 70, Office of R.M.C. for Greenville County, S. C.

The said Garrison McClure died intestate on the 6th day of January, 1948, leaving surviving him as his sole heirs at law, his widow, Allie M. McClure, his son, Richard M. McClure and his daughter, Evelyn M. Landis.
