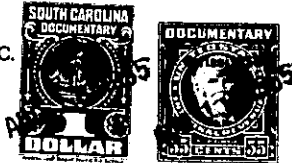

Know All Men by These Presents:

That I, C. Paul Manly, in consideration of the sum of One and No/100-... in the State aforesaid, and exchange of property valued at \$499.00 DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

R. T. Dempsey, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina being known and designated as Lot No. 5 of Paris Mountain Heights as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "HH", Page 151 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in a thirty foot road at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5 and running thence along said thirty foot road N. 37-20 E. 38 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 53-00 E. 62 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 5 and 6; thence along the line of Lot No. 6 N. 43-20 W. 209.5 feet to an iron pin in the center of a thirty foot road; thence along the center of said road S. 56-00 W. 87.6 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence along the line of Lot No. 4 S. 40-10 E. 221 feet to the beginning corner.

The above described property is part of the same conveyed to me by Grady L. Foster by deed dated August 10, 1954 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 505, page 484.
