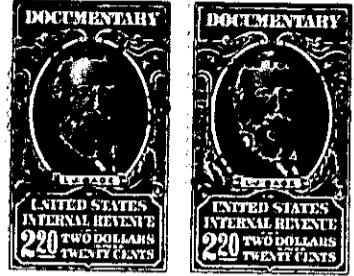

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Francis Avery Hightower and Marie S. Hightower Dill (formerly Marie S. Hightower) in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four Thousand and No/100-----Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Thomas A. Mullinax and Mary C. Mullinax (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Thomas A. Mullinax and Mary C. Mullinax, their heirs and assigns forever:

those all that pieces parcels or lots of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina on Tugaloo Road and being described as follows:

Lot #1
 BEGINNING at a stake on line of property now or formerly owned by J. H. Roe and running thence N. $40\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.16 chains to a stone on the Tugaloo Road; thence along said Road S. $45\frac{1}{2}$ W. 3.33 chains to a stone in the Road; thence S. $40\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.97 chains to a stone in line of property now or formerly owned by J. H. Roe; thence along said line N. $49\frac{1}{4}$ E. 3.33 chains to the beginning corner and containing 1.35 acres more or less.

Lot #2
 BEGINNING at a stake in the center of Tugaloo Road and running thence S. $40\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.14 chains to a stone in Roe's line; thence along Roe line N. $49\frac{1}{4}$ E. 1.00 chains to a stone; thence N. $40\frac{1}{2}$ W. 1.23 chains to an iron pin on Tugaloo Road; thence along said Road S. 43 W. 1.00 chain to the beginning corner and containing .42 acres more or less.

Lot #3
 BEGINNING at corner of property now or formerly owned by Gullick and in the Tugaloo Road and running thence southeast with Gullick line to property now or formerly owned by Mrs. Elizabeth Roe; thence with her line to the new Tugaloo Road; thence with the new Tugaloo Road to the beginning corner and containing $1\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less.

The above property was conveyed to the grantors in Deed Book 151, at Page 171, and Francis Avery Hightower subsequently conveyed his interest to Avery F. Hightower in Deed Book 295, at Page 141, and Avery F. Hightower died July 1, 1946 and devised his interest to Marie S. Hightower for life and then to Francis A. Hightower.
