Know All Men by These Presents:

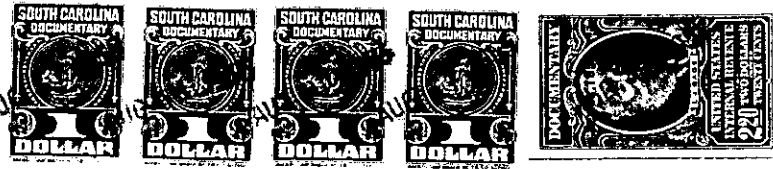

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Jesse J. Chastain, his heirs and assigns, forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the Southwest side of Parker Road, near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 7 on map of Development No. 1 of Victor-Monaghan Company property made by Dalton & Neves, Engineers, December, 1941, and having, according to said plat, which is recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Plat Book M., at Page 39, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Parker Road, joint front corner of Lots No. 6 and 7, said pin also being 284 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the point where the Southwest side of Parker Road intersects with the Northwest side of Louise Avenue, and running thence with the common line of Lot No. 6 and 7, S. 38-30 W. 275 feet to an iron pin; thence along the line of Lot No. 66, N. 51-48 W. 92 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner of Lots No. 7 and 8; thence with the common line of Lot No. 7 and 8, N. 38-30 E. 275 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest side of Parker Road; thence with the Southwest side of Parker Road, S. 51-48 E. 92 feet to the beginning corner.

This property is conveyed subject to the building restrictions and protective covenants as fully set forth by instrument dated February 20, 1942, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C., in Deeds Volume 243, at page 146.
