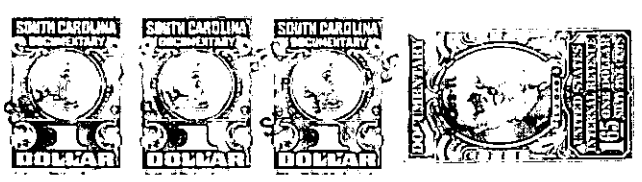

to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said grantee(s) Lewis E. Wilson, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate about 1 1/2 miles Northwest from Apache Mill, lying on the South side of a surfaced treated road that leads from State Highway No. 14 at Frohawk Creek to the Gap Creek Road, and having the following: notes and bounds according to a plat thereof made by J. G. Bruce, surveyor, dated Feb. 6, 1950 and recorded in plat book T page 288, Greenville County R. S. Office.  
BEGINNING at the intersection of the surfaced road above mentioned and with another country road and runs thence along the said surfaced road S. 29-16 E., 27 feet to a bend; thence S. 36-44 E., 187 feet to a bend; thence S. 40-48 E., 560 feet to a bend; thence S. 28-57 E., 354.7 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving said road N. 05-00 W., 678 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 13-70 W., 327 feet to an iron pin or County Road; thence along said County Road N. 02-00 E., 200 feet to the beginning corner, containing Ten (10) acres more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Lewis W. Hughes by deed recorded in Book 423 page 373, Greenville County R. S. Office.
