Dewey Oxner, in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of exchange of property valued at Twelve Hundred Seventy-five (\$1275.00)--- DOLLARS, to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marshall Lee Rhodes and Thomasena Rhodes

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in the City of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designed as Lot Fifteen (15) on plat of Carver Court made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March, 1955, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book I I, page 107, and having according to said plat the following courses and distances, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Elder Street joint front corner of Lots 14 and 15 and running thence along the line of Lot No. 14 S. 37-05 E. 149.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 52-31 W. 70 feet to an iron pin corner of Lot No. 16; thence along the line of Lot No. 16 N. 37-05 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Elder Street; thence along Elder Street N. 52-58 E. 70 feet to the beginning corner.

The lot above described is conveyed subject to the covenants and restrictions recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 526, page 297, which are made a part hereof as fully as if set out herein, and to the public utility easement granted to the Duke Power Company, dated September 1, 1955, and not yet recorded.

The lot herein conveyed constitutes a portion of the property conveyed to us by Jessie D. Webster by deed dated September 28, 1954, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 509, page 122.
