Use of premises for any business other than herein called for shall cancel this lease if the lessor so desires and give notice of same in writing.

If the business is discontinued or the premises vacated before the expiration of the lease then the whole of the unexpired time becomes immediately due and payable.

Outside signs to be erected that may connect with the parapet or any other outside part of the building must be consented to by the lessor before being erected.

In the event the Lessee rents the entire building, then he agrees to pay a monthly rental of \$250.00 as aforesaid. The Lescor agrees to carry fire and hazard insurance on the building, and the Lessor is not to be responsible for water damage to the contents of said building. The Lessee agrees to carry liability incurs ce and fire insurance on his contents and property in the building.
