to the grantor(s) in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the grantee(s) (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said GARVIN E. TURNER and CHARLINE TURNER, their heirs and assigns, forever:

ALL that lot of land situate on the Northeast side of High Valley Boulevard near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as Lot No. 27 on plat of Fresh Meadow Farms, Section I, made by L. H. Woodward, May 21, 1945, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book M, page 127, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of High Valley Boulevard, at joint front corner of Lots 26 and 27 of Section I, and running thence with the line of Lot 26, N. 41-30 E., 331 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 81-25 E., 135 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-05 E., 73.9 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 23, S. 59-00 W., 377.5 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of High Valley Boulevard; thence with the curve of High Valley Boulevard, (the chord being N. 54-21 W., 58.5 feet) to the beginning corner.
