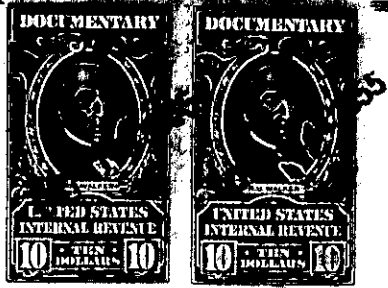
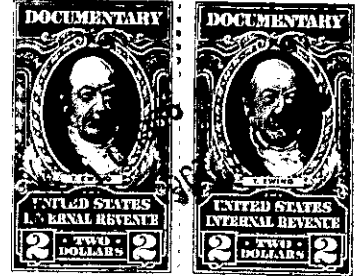
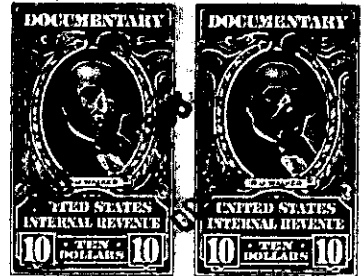

D. Cunningham; thence continuing with the Cunningham line in a southeasterly direction 120.8 feet to an iron pin east of a well; thence S. 6-01 W. 372.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 32-15 E. 1386.7 feet to an iron pin by a stone; thence S. 23-45 W. 937.2 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 84-22 W. 1023 feet to an iron pin; thence due North 561.8 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-45 W. 47 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 50-48 E. 47 feet to an iron pin; thence due North 150 feet to a black gum in the north bank of a creek; thence with the line of W. M. E. Townsend, N. 29-37 W. 724.6 feet to an iron pin on the southern edge of the Old Spartanburg Road; thence due West 55.4 feet to a point; thence N. 27-15 W. 25.1 feet to a point, the point of beginning.
