(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said...Bernice Ballenger Moon and.....

her heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, near the corporate limits of the City of Greer and on the East side of North Main Street Extension-formerly Mostella Road, having the following courses and distances according to a plat thereof made by L.B. Aull, R.E., November 30, 1940, to wit: BEGINNING on an iron pin on the eastern side of North Main Street Extension, corner with the Mrs. Leona M. Brockman lot, and runs thence with her line S. 83 E. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 5.00 W. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 83 W. 250 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of North Main Street Extension; thence therewith S. 5.00 E. 100 feet to the beginning, being all of that lot of land conveyed to the grantor by James C. Moon, Trustee, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 242, at page 177.

Also, all of that parcel or tract of land with improvements thereon in Saluda Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, in School District # 465, on branch waters of South Tyger River, adjoining lands now or formerly owned by Dorthula Newman, Joe Pink Pittman, J.D. Bridges and B.L. Still, containing 50 acres, more or less, said tract of land located about 21 miles north from the Greenville County Courthouse and on a road that leads from the Ridge Road by or near Cross Plains Baptist Church to the State Road, near what is known as the "Winds," and being all of that land conveyed to the grantor by D.F. Hughey by deed recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 531, at page 93.

Also, all of that other parcel or lot of land in Saluda Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as Lot No. 4 in Section No. 10 on a plat of property known as "Lazy City", recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 512, at page 371, reference thereunto being made for a complete and detailed description of said lot. This is the same property conveyed to the grantor by deed recorded in said R.M.C. Office in Deed Book 512, at page 371.

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
