CHARTER
BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE

WHEREAS, WILLIAM D. MATTHEWS, 402 Furman Road, Greenville, S. C.
and
JAMES C. MUNDY, III, 15th. Paris View Drive, Greenville, S. C.

did on the 23rd. day of June, 1955, file with the Secretary of State a written Declaration,
signed by themselves, setting forth:

FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is BILL MATTHEWS PLUMBING CO., INC.

THIRD: That the principal place of business is GREENVILLE, S. C.
(402 Furman Road)

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is engage in general
plumbing contracting, purchasing and installing plumbing fixtures, water
lines and sanitary sewers, and performing any other work incidental
thereto as well as buying and selling real estate in connection therewith.

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FIFTH: That the amount of the capital stock is Five Thousand (\$5,000.00)-----Dollars
payable upon call by the Board of Directors

SIXTH: That the number of shares into which the capital stock is divided is Fifty (50)
of the par value of One Hundred (\$100.00)-----Dollars.

SEVENTH: That, after due notice, a meeting of the subscribers was held on the 1st day of
June, 1955, at which a majority of all stock in value being present in person or by proxy, the follow-
ing were elected directors:

William D. Matthews, James C. Mundy, III, and J. W. Boone

EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President, William D. Matthews;
as Vice-President, James C. Mundy, III; as Secretary, James C. Mundy, III;
as Treasurer, William D. Matthews

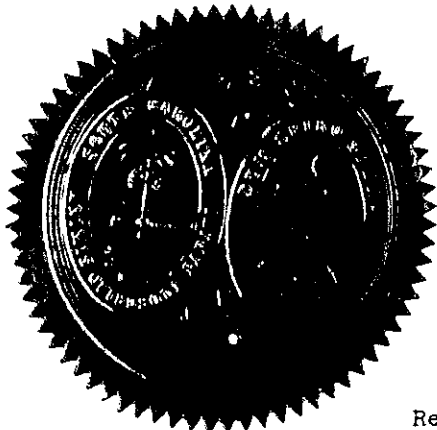
NINTH: That all requirements of Title 12, Article 1, Chapter 2, Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1952, and all amend-
ments thereto have been duly and fully complied with, 50 per cent. of the aggregate amount of the capital stock having been subscribed
by bona fide subscribers, 20 per cent. of the capital stock subscribed having been paid to the Treasurer, and three days' public notice
of the intention to file this Declaration with the Secretary of State having been given in The Observer

a newspaper published in the County of Greenville

NOW, THEREFORE, I, O. FRANK THORNTON, Secretary of State, by virtue of the authority in me vested by the
aforesaid Code and Acts amendatory thereto, do hereby certify that the said Company has been fully organized according to the laws
of South Carolina, under the name and for the purposes indicated in their written declaration, and that they are fully authorized to
commence business under their charter; and I do hereby direct that a copy of this certificate be filed and recorded in the office of the
Register of Mesne Conveyance or Clerk of Court in each county where such Corporation shall have a business office.
