All those pieces, parcels or lots of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 26 and 27 as shown by survey of Dalton & Neves, Engineers, made April, 1945 and marked Plat No. 2, property of W. S. Bradley, said plat being of record in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book "O", at page 169, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Western side of Bahan Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 25 and 26, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 88-10 W. 331.3 feet to a stake; thence S. 0-31 W. 199 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 27 and 28; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 88-10 E. 335.6 feet to a stake on the Western side of Bahan Street; thence with said Bahan Street, N. 0-42 W. 199.2 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by James H. Rollins and Martha B. Rollins by deed dated June 17, 1953 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Vol. 480, at page 265.
