Know All Men by These Presents, That

I, Katherine Bush Adams,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the

sum of eleven thousand six hundred ninety-six and 40/100 (\$11,696.40) dollars

to me paid by Katherine Bush Adams, of the City of Greenville, S. C.,

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Katherine Bush Adams, her heirs or assigns:

I, John J. Elliott, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, do hereby convey to Katherine Bush Adams, of the City of Greenville, S. C., all that certain piece, or tract of land, containing two hundred and twenty-seven (227) acres of land, more or less, lying and bounded on the west by the State Highway, running from the State of Georgia into the State of South Carolina, and having such other boundaries, as is more fully described in a survey made by John J. Elliott, on October 2, 1955, which survey is filed in my office in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County, S. C. Said tract is bounded on the south by Colvin's Creek, on the east by the property of W. A. Cope, on the southwest by the property of W. A. Cope, a line west of Greenway Building, the creek being on the north side, across which lie lands of C. L. Tucker and by a public road across which lie lands of Mr. J. J. Elliott; on the south by land of W. A. Cope, on the west by land of W. A. Cope, on the northwest by lands of John McRae, lands of W. A. Cope, lands of John P. Kirby. This is the same tract of land described as Tract 2 in a deed by J. Inman, Carter, to him, in Greenville County to Thomas W. Edwards, dated February 27, 1871, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for Greenville County in Deed Book "A" at page 171. Prior to the survey of John J. Elliott, said tract of land was said to contain two hundred and twenty-seven (227) acres, more or less.
